Diploma: Grade 11 and 12 courses that are C, M or U type, including prerequisites

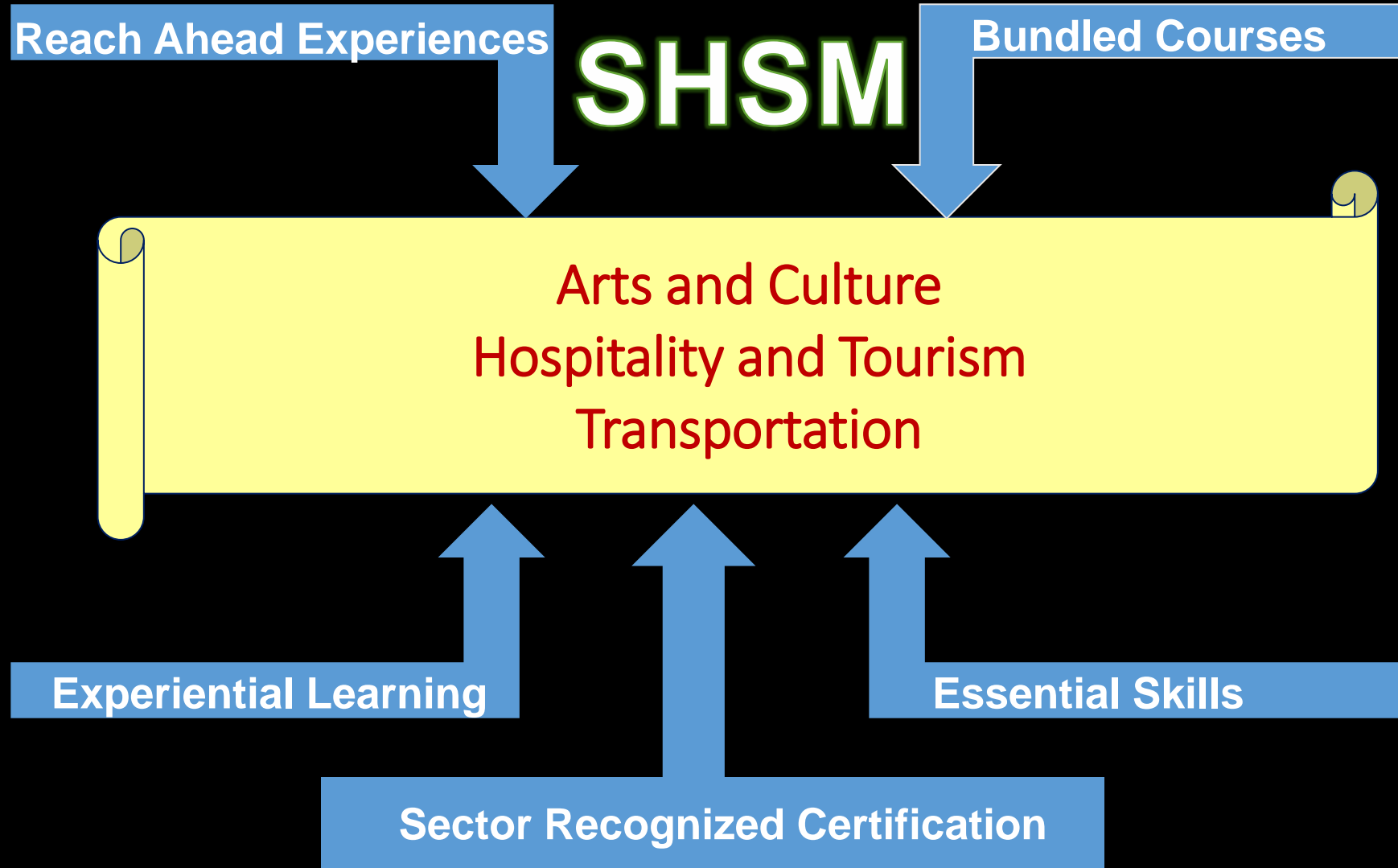

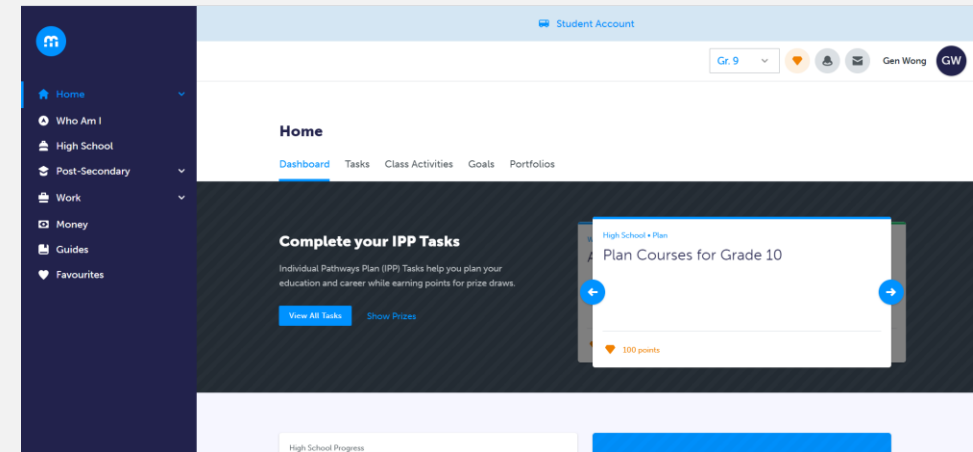
